

### **Mini Curriculum vitae**

Henriette Monteiro Cordeiro de Azeredo is a food engineer, M.Sc. and D.Sc. in Food Technology, post-doc at WRRRC/ARS/USDA (2008). She is an Embrapa researcher since 2001, where her work has been focused on edible, biodegradable and nanocomposite food packaging materials and their impact on food quality and stability. She has published 34 refereed papers, 1 book with 2 editions (as editor and main author), and a number of book chapters.
